AP-3C Orion Aircraft Precautionary Landing In Fiji

NATURE OF THE INCIDENT:

- A RAAF AP-3C Orion aircraft, with 17 crew, returning to Australia from Samoa has made a precautionary landing at Nadi International airport because of a problem with one of its engines.

THE DATE AND TIME OF THE INCIDENT:

- The incident occurred at 0920 (AEST) on 24 June 2013.

ACTIONS CURRENTLY UNDERWAY:

- The aircraft has been secured and is parked on the International tarmac at Nadi International (Gate G2).
- Of the 17 crew, 12 members will depart Fiji today, while 5 crew members will remain in Nadi until spare parts and maintenance personnel can be delivered and the aircraft repaired.
- The Australian High Commission is in contact with the crew and providing support.
