Four Army Members Injured in Vehicle Accident

NATURE OF THE INCIDENT:

- On 27 June 2013, four Australian Army members were injured as a result of a single motor vehicle accident on the Riverina Highway approximately six kilometres north of Albury, NSW.
- One member has sustained very serious injuries and was aero-medically evacuated to a Melbourne Hospital.
- The other three members sustained serious injuries and are being treated at the Albury Base Hospital.
- The members were off duty at the time of the accident.

THE DATE AND TIME OF THE INCIDENT:

- The accident occurred at approximately 0100hrs on 27 June 2013.

ACTIONS CURRENTLY UNDERWAY:

- The members' families have been notified and Defence is providing support.
- Service police are providing assistance to the New South Wales Police crash investigation.
