C-130 INCIDENT AT KABUL INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT – 24 APRIL 2014

NATURE OF THE INCIDENT

- A Royal Australian Air Force C-130J with 12 people onboard was involved in an incident after the aircraft diverged from the runway after landing at Kabul International Airport, Afghanistan.
- The aircraft stopped 70 metres from the runway.
- As a precautionary measure, an emergency evacuation was ordered and Kabul International Airport Emergency Services attended the scene but no significant action was required.
- No personnel were injured as a result of the incident and the event has not affected ongoing operations.
- The exact cause of the incident is unknown.

DATE AND TIME OF THE INCIDENT

- The incident occurred at approximately 6pm on 24th April 2014, Australian Eastern Standard Time.

ACTIONS CURRENTLY UNDERWAY

- The aircraft has been moved to a parking bay and quarantined pending the arrival of an aircraft accident investigation team and maintenance crews.
